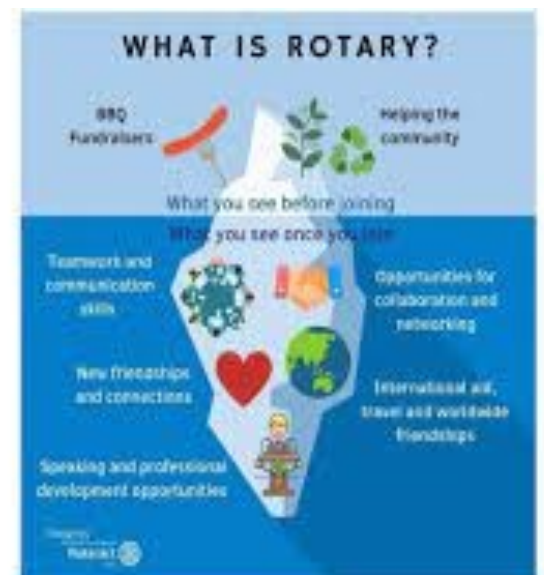

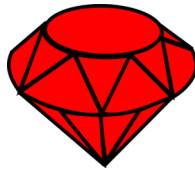
COASTGUARD

MARTIN TRENDALL AWARD: BROWNS BAY ROTARIAN OF THE YEAR

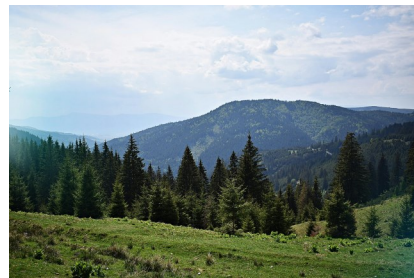

Rotary will be governed as a zone, covering Australia, NZ and all of the Pacific Islands. There will be a Community Group Leader providing

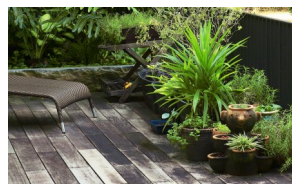
